

Code of Conduct

The Beaver Valley Hospital Wellness Center is a public facility designed for the use of residents of Beaver County and the surrounding areas. The Wellness Center is intended to be a welcoming and safe space for individuals to gather and socialize. Participants of the Wellness Center are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that most people would find reasonable, and that does not infringe on the enjoyment of other participants. While an exhaustive list of inappropriate activities is impractical, the following outlines the basic principles of appropriate use of the Wellness Center.

Participants agree to observe the following when attending the Wellness Center:

- Smoking is not permitted in the facility or on the grounds at any time.
- Alcohol is not permitted at the Wellness Center or on the grounds at any time.
- Offensive language is not permitted at the Wellness Center.
- The Wellness Center structure, grounds, furnishings, and fixtures must be treated with care and respect at all times.
- **Youth under the age of 8** must be directly supervised
- Guests must obtain entry through authorized means, such as membership, daily admission passes, or participation in authorized hospital programs and events.
- Unauthorized entry will result in loss of facility privileges.
- No commercial activity is permitted, including requests for donations, private instruction (such as fitness floors or therapy areas), collecting admissions, selling products, or soliciting individuals for agencies, personal services, or businesses.
- Organized practices are not allowed
- State and local policies, laws, and regulations must be observed at all times.
- Headphones must be used while listening to personal music.
- Members must scan their pass at the front desk to gain entry into the fitness areas, track, and/or courts. All guests must pay for a day pass or be enrolled in a program/event to access these facilities.
- Using another person's pass to gain access is prohibited.
- Appropriate athletic attire required

- The Wellness Center is a family facility designed for guests of all ages. Please dress appropriately in all areas of the facility.
- Use of bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, hoverboards, and drones are prohibited inside the facility.
- Personal belongings must be secured in lockers; the Wellness Center is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Participants are expected to:

- Be able to function on their own or with the assistance of an escort but independently from Wellness Center Staff or volunteers.
- Maintain healthy and inoffensive personal hygiene.
- Use voice, language, and behavior that will not offend or disturb other participants or staff.
- Treat others with courtesy and consideration.
- Obtain authorization for any photography or videography (personal, commercial, or otherwise), from staff before filming.
- Comply with all applicable state and local laws, policies, ordinances, and regulations.
- Comply with any direction from Wellness Center staff and follow any other rules that they deem necessary and appropriate to provide guests with a safe and welcoming environment.
- Comply with Beaver Valley Hospital Wellness Center employees per the rules and regulations outlined above, as well as any other direction staff deems necessary to maintain the safety and enjoyment of all guests.
- Failure to comply with staff requests, directions, or instructions will result in loss of privileges, including removal from the building and criminal trespassing.
